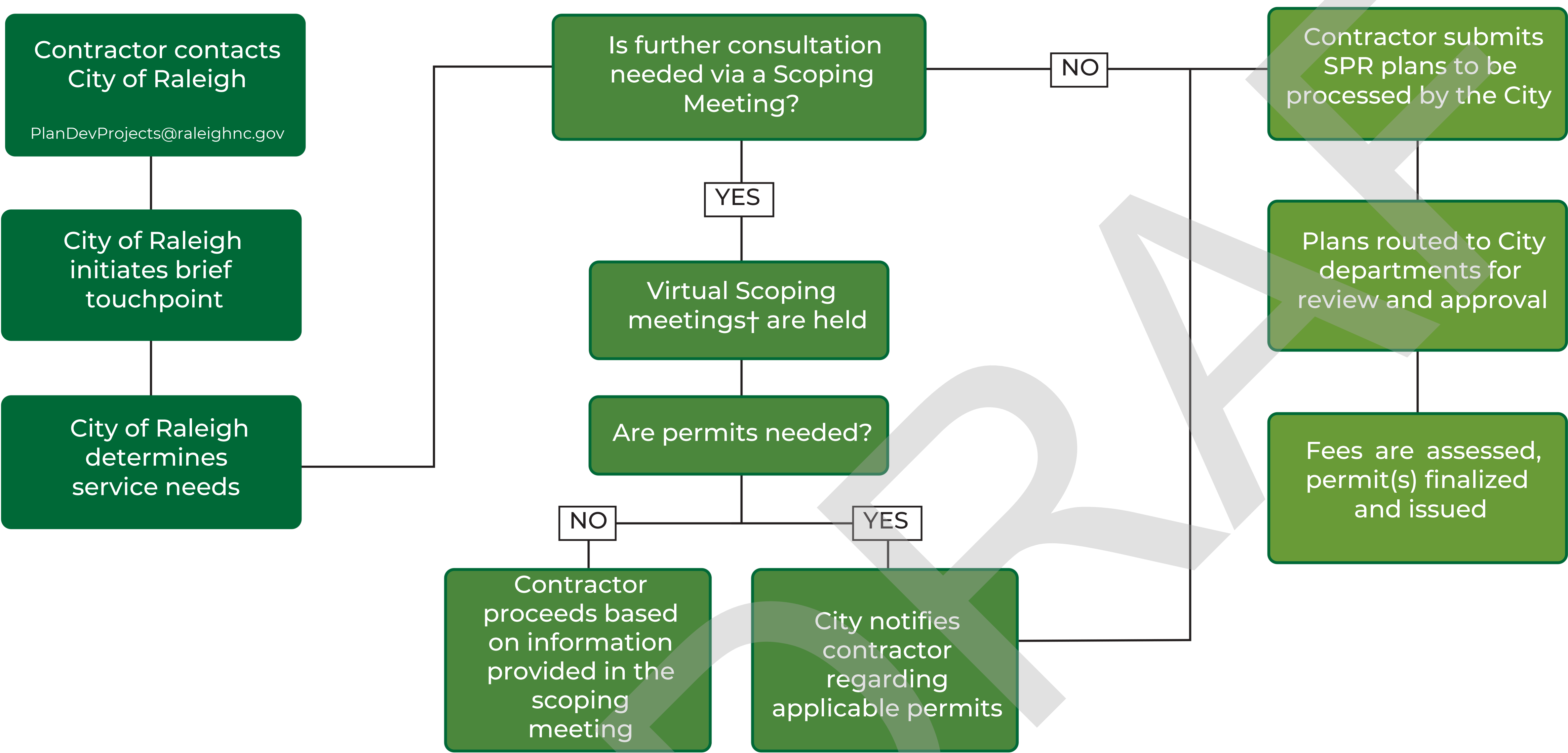


Consultation for State Sponsored Construction Process



In accordance with the *North Carolina Statute 160D-913 (Public Buildings)*, this process map outlines the steps necessary for facilitating consultations with contractors and representatives of State-Sponsored construction projects.



*Site Permit Review (SPR): Combined submittal and review process that allows a development project to obtain all site approvals and relevant permits.

† Scoping Meeting: Conducted with multi-departmental team of reviewers that assesses infrastructure impacts and the need for permits.

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Applicable Permits for State Sponsored Projects

Department	Permit	Permit Description
Raleigh Stormwater	Stormwater Control	Required for post-construction stormwater compliance per UDO Section 9.2.2. if any impervious area added.
	Stormwater Conveyance	Permit required for pipes and swales in City ROW.
	Floodplain Permit	Required per UDO Section 9.3. if applicable.
Raleigh Water	Water Supply Watershed	Required per UDO Section 9.5. if applicable.
	Stub Permit	Required for tapping a public water or sewer main with a service line.
	Utility Connection Permit	Required when requesting a meter.
	Infrastructure Permit Water/Sewer	Required when installing public water or sewer mains.

Note: Erosion and Sediment Control and Riparian Buffers are reviewed by NCDEQ.
