
## Sidewalk Petitions

- Petitions issued for residential neighborhood streets upon request
- Petitions for sidewalk only are not assessable
- Streets must have existing curb & gutter, be publicly maintained & inside city limits
- Who votes: Only property owners who own parcels with abutting frontage
- ✤ How to vote: Via mail, e-mail, or online voting method
- Threshold: Minimum 50% plus one additional vote of responses received




- Council District: C
- Recommendation:
  - 5 foot wide sidewalk on 3 ½ foot setback from curb
  - East side of Freeman Street from existing sidewalk to Postell Street
  - South side of Postell Street from Freeman Street to Coleman Street
  - Both sides of Coleman Street from Postell Street to existing sidewalk
  - Project Length: Approximately 790 linear feet of sidewalk
- Estimated Construction Cost \$133,000
- Not Assessable





From Freeman Street along south side of Postell meeting and extending from existing sidewalk on the south side of Postell Street






From Postell Street at Coleman Street meeting existing sidewalk on both sides of the street at rear entrance of Hunter Elementary School
