PROJECT DETAILS

- **Location:** The project is located on Fox Road between Spring Forest Road and Balance Fox Drive. See attached map.
- **Description of Project:** The project involves widening and adding curb and gutter at the locations that currently do not have curb and gutter. Sidewalk will also be installed where there is none within the project limits. The roadway will be restriped to include bicycle lanes on both sides of the roadway. A new connection to the Spring Forest Park Greenway will be installed.
- **Need/Benefit:** Completion of the sidewalk and installation of bicycle lanes will increase pedestrian safety and enhance mobility along the corridor.
- **Assessments:** \$32/LF of frontage along the curb and gutter installation within the limits of the project.
- **Funding:** The project is funded by Transportation Bond funds and is scheduled for construction in 2017.

UPCOMING ACTIVITIES

- Comments from today's meeting will be carefully reviewed and incorporated into the final design where possible.
- Acquire right-of-way and easements necessary to construct the project.
- Construction is anticipated to begin in Winter of 2016.
- Complete construction of the project by Fall 2017.
