

Project Scope

- Complete Streets
 - Increase safety for all users (pedestrians, bicyclists, and vehicles).
 - Separated pedestrian and bicycle path on parks side and sidewalk on residential side.
 - Roundabouts and raised median slow traffic and promote safe crossings.


