


EXISTING CONDITIONS

DIXIE FOREST RD.

- 2-lane roadway with some existing curb & gutter and sidewalk installed with previous development.
- Speed limit is 35mph for school zone.



OLD WAKE FOREST RD.

- 2-lane roadway with some existing curb & gutter and sidewalk installed with previous development.
- Posted speed limit is 45mph.
- Average Daily Traffic is 18,000 vpd

- Provide new bicycle and pedestrian facilities that provide connectivity.

- Existing Parking Lots










ROADWAY TYPICAL SECTIONS

Old Wake Forest Rd. Proposed 4-Lane Divided Typical Section




Dixie Forest Rd. Proposed 3-Lane Typical Section


