### About:

The project is at the 65% design phase. Some of the features that the project includes are:

- Curb and gutter:
- 12' multi-purpose path (north side):
- 8' sidewalk (south side):
- Additional crosswalks at Maybrook Ave:
- Crosswalks at Barwell Road:
- HAWK pedestrian signal near River Knoll Dr (east):
- Combination of grass and concrete medians:

- Traffic signal upgrades: and,
- Improvements to the Barwell Road Intersection.

### What's New:

Based on public feedback we made design changes, we:

- Removed 5' bike lanes from both sides of Poole Road;
- Provided 12' multi-purpose path (north side);
- Provided 8' sidewalk (south side); and,
- Revised U-Turn bulb at Green Needles Blvd.



### Typical Section:

The project includes curb and gutter along both sides of Poole Road and two 11-foot travel lanes in both directions with a 17-foot wide grass median. Left turn lanes with a 4-foot wide concrete median are provided at Green Needles Blvd., River Knoll Dr. (west), and Riverview Rd. Full movement intersections with left turn lanes are proposed at Maybrook Dr./Hickory Hollow Ln., Jeffrey St., and Barwell Rd. A 12-foot wide multipurpose path is included along the north side of the road that extends to the Neuse River Trail parking lot. An 8-foot wide sidewalk is proposed along the south side of Poole Road.
