

Project Purpose

- 6-foot sidewalk along north side of Carolina Pines Ave.
- 10-foot multi-use path along south side of Carolina Pines Ave.
- Traffic signal at Lake Wheeler Rd.
- Traffic calming measures, including roundabouts at Oak Rd. & Granite St.
- Boardwalk structure over the lake
- Improvement of stormwater infrastructure
- Landscaping



Recent Activity

- Initial advertisement November 27, 2024
 - Closed February 12, 2025 2 bids received
- Readvertised February 13, 2025
 - Closed February 21, 2025 3 bids received and opened
 - Lowest Responsive Bidder: Cardinal Civil, LLC. \$21 M
 - Bid exceeded budget
- Bid award approved by City Council on April 1, 2025
 - Contract execution May 2025


Start of Construction

Goal - July/August 2025 (2-year duration)



Construction Phasing

- Construction planned to start from east of Lake Wheeler Rd.
- Continue towards South Saunders St.
- Final phases planned, are traffic signal work at intersections





Traffic Impacts

- Expect lane closures
- Intermittent road closures



Night and weekend work may be required





Staking Notice

- Survey crews will begin staking soon.
- Please do not <u>remove</u> or <u>move</u> any stakes.
 - Mark project boundaries and work areas.
 - Minimizes need to re-stake.
 - Tampered stakes could cause project delays.
