Widening Project

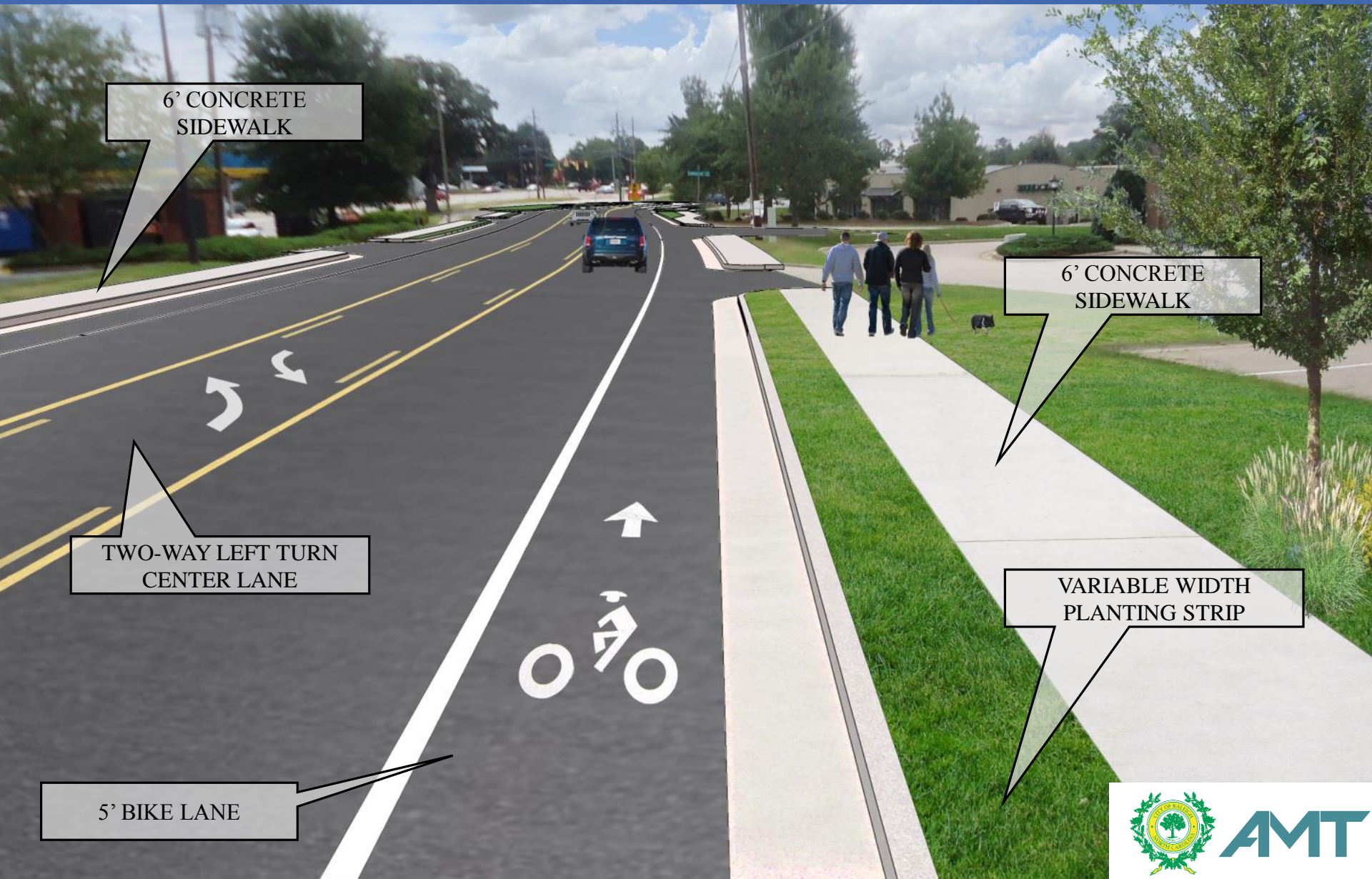


- Reconstruct Damaged Pavement
- Widen to a Three-Lane Section
(According to Comprehensive Plan)
- Add Facilities For Pedestrians and
Bicycles on both sides of the road
- Add pedestrian refuge at signalized
intersections (where applicable)



- Minimize Property Encroachment
- Proximity Parking Lots
- Existing Utilities
- Stormwater

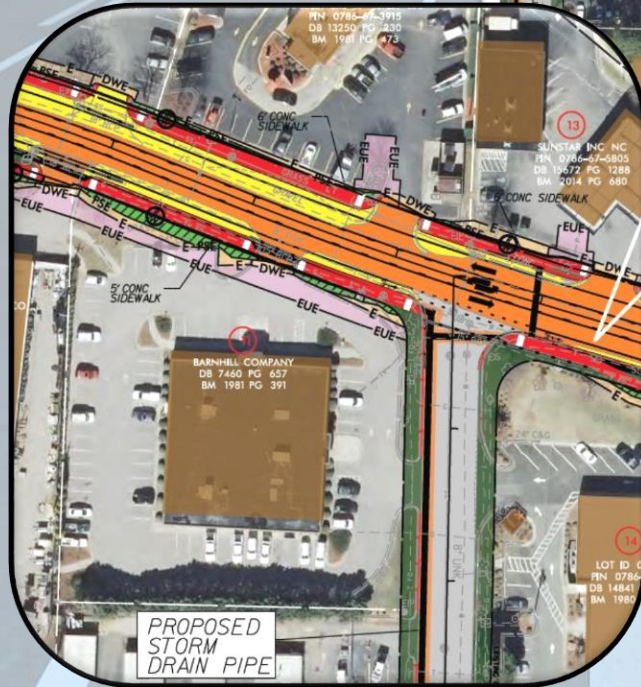

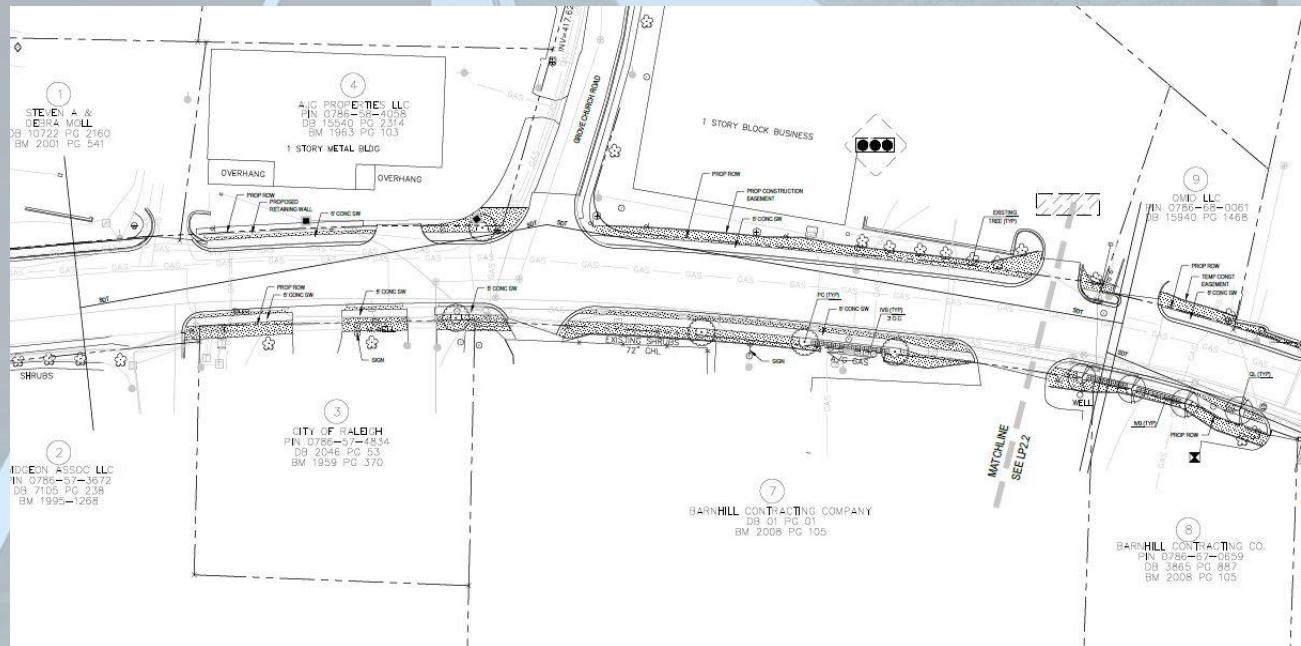
Water Quantity Management

- Oversized pipes for additional storage
- 30" RCP along Commercial Avenue



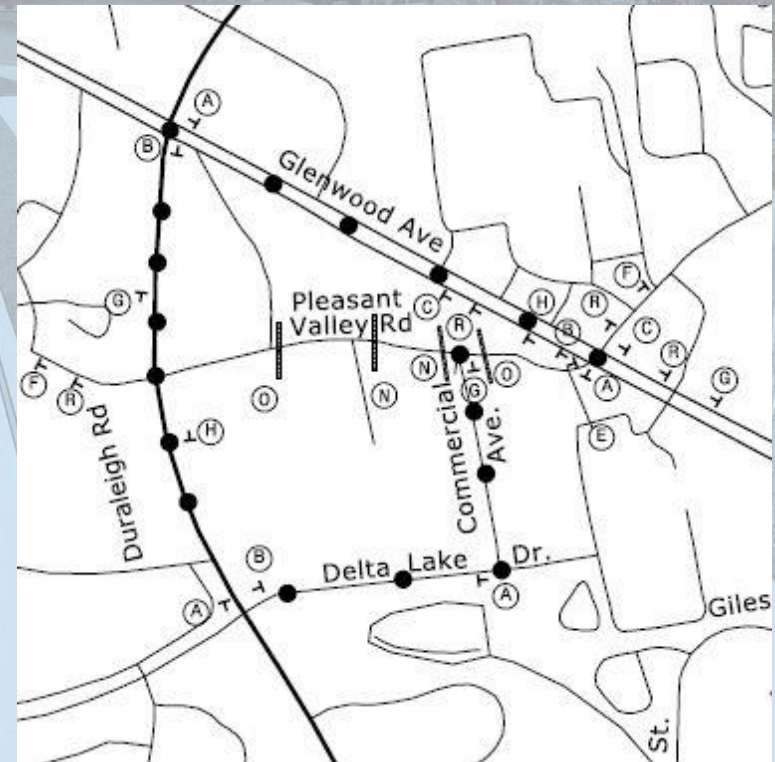
Planting Objectives

- Coordinate with Parks and Recreation
- Select plants that foster design cohesion and uniformity
- Mitigate undesirable views
- Maintain site lines for safety



Temporary Closure

- Maintaining access to properties
- Allows flexibility to contractor
- Coordination with Fire Station No. 17 and Barnhill
- Short detour



- First Public Meeting was held on October 19, 2016
- Second Public Meeting scheduled for March 15, 2018



On December 8, 2015 the Raleigh City Council approved a \$398,533 contract agreement with AMT for design , SUE, survey, landscaping, and geotechnical services.

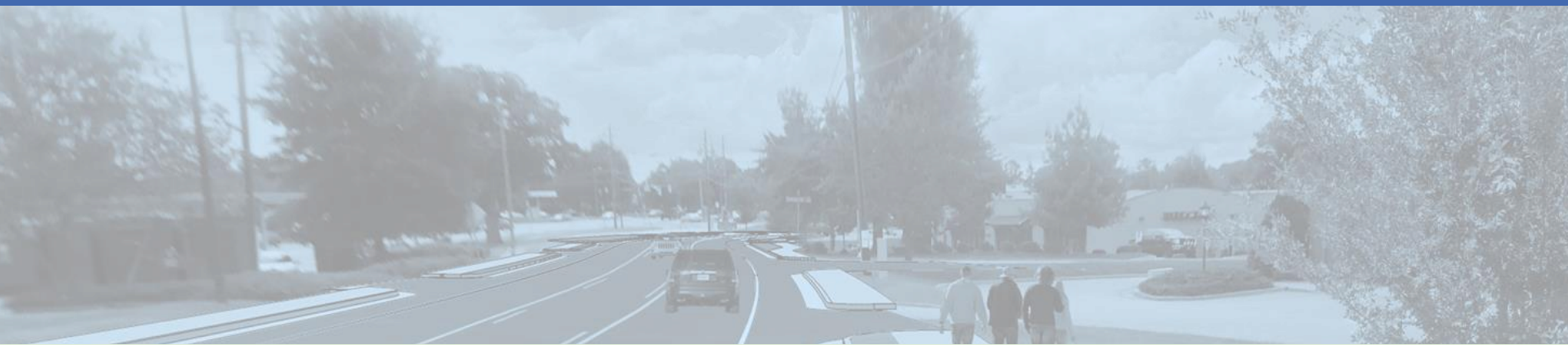
Estimated Project Cost

\$4.3 Million Including Construction and Right of Way

Project Schedule:

- Complete Right of Way Acquisition – Fall 2018 (6-8 Month Duration)
- Award Construction Contract – Winter 2018
- Complete Construction – Fall 2019
