

Project Location

- From the Pullen Road roundabout to Roberts Street
- Adding sidewalk on Sanford, Everett, and Bedford Avenues





Project Purpose

- Create a safe multi-modal complete Street
 - Improve Sidewalk Connections
 - Add crosswalks
 - Bike Lanes
 - Street Trees
 - Update transit stops
 - Replace a section of water main and sewer main







What to expect – General

- Roadway construction expected to take 1 year.
- Start/End work area signs will be installed soon.
- Expect temporary fence installations along the limits of disturbance (typically along easement areas) in the next few weeks.



What to expect – General

- No road closures are expected
- Sidewalk closures and detours along the project limits
- One lane in each direction will be maintained
- There may be periodic flagging operations
- No lane closures between 7:00 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 – 7:00 p.m., Monday – Friday
- Some Saturday work



What to expect

- Residential and Business access will be maintained
- Expect written notification by the contractor,
 Moffat Pipe Inc., in advance of construction.
