The subject property is bounded by Halifax Community Center to the north; Halifax Street, Oaks Street, Oaks Chase Lane, and multi-family residential to the east; Undeveloped wooded land, construction area, electric substation, and Seaboard Station to the south; and CSX Raleigh Railyard to the west. Description of the Proposed Project [24 CFR 50.12 & 58.32; 40 CFR 1508.25]:

1013 Halifax Street is a vacant 2.27 acre Raleigh Housing Authority property. The City of Raleigh uses the property for sports recreation programs in association with their community center adjacent to the north property line. RHA plans to reposition 1013 Halifax Street using a Section 18 application and has provided for that action in its Annual Plan. Upon HUD approval of this application, RHA intends to disposition the property to a third-party entity to develop new housing on the site. The subject property consists of two (2) grass sports fields and undeveloped wooded land. Utilities were observed in the vicinity of the subject property.
