# The Affordable Connectivity Program

### Federal Assistance for Internet Bills & Getting a Computer

The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is a <u>Federal</u> <u>Communications Commission (FCC) program</u> that replaces the Emergency Broadband Benefit Program (EBB Program) to help low-income households pay for internet service and connected devices. If your household is <u>eligible</u>, you can receive:

- Up to a \$30/month discount on your internet service
- Up to a \$75/month discount if your household is on qualifying Tribal lands
- A one-time discount of up to \$100 for a laptop, tablet, or desktop computer (with a co-payment of more than \$10 but less than \$50)

Only one monthly service discount and one device discount is allowed per household. To receive the connected device discount, consumers need to enroll in the ACP with a <u>participating provider that offers</u> <u>connected devices</u> (Note: not all internet company offer device discounts.) The internet company will provide the discount to the consumer.

#### How to Qualify:

- Based on your household income (refer to list)
- If you, your child or dependent participates in certain government assistance programs such as SNAP, Medicaid, WIC or other programs
- If you, your child or dependent receives a Lifeline benefit. Lifeline is a <u>Federal Communications</u> <u>Commission program</u> to help make communications services more affordable for low-income consumers.

#### How to Apply:

- Online: Login or create a new account to complete the <u>ACP application online</u>
- Mail: Complete the application and Household Worksheet and send copies of your proof documentation to the ACP Support Center at PO Box 7081, London, KY 40742.



• Through Your Provider: Contact your phone or internet company

### Household Income Limits (48 Contiguous States, D.C., and Territories):

You qualify for ACP assistance if you make no more than the listed amounts below per year. These amounts are 200% over the federal poverty guidelines and are reflected by household size. You may need to show proof of income, such as three consecutive pay stubs or a tax return.

#### Income Limits Per Household Size:

1 Person - \$25,760 2 People - \$34,840 3 People - \$43,920 4 People - 53,000 5 People - \$62,080 6 People - \$71,160 7 People - \$80,240 8 or More People - For each additional person, add \$9,080
