

### Raleigh Home Repair Programs

Dear Homeowner.

Thank you for your interest in the <u>City of Raleigh's Home Rehab and Repair Programs</u> including the **Home Revitalization Program** and **Limited Repair Program**.

#### Who runs the programs?

The City of Raleigh partners with <u>Preserving Home</u>, a local nonprofit to review applications, administer these programs, and do the home repairs. Preserving Home also runs similar programs for other entities besides the City of Raleigh. By filling out this application, Preserving Home will evaluate if applicants are eligible for Raleigh's Home Revitalization and Limited Repair programs, as well as determine if applicants qualify for other available programs and resources. This ensures that Preserving Home considers how they can best serve homeowners.

#### How do homeowners receive funding?

Homeowners receive funding through a <u>0% interest, forgivable loan</u>. No monthly payments are required. Loan payments are deferred for five years—and fully forgiven if the homeowner remains in the home for the full five-year term. The loan amounts for each program are:

- Limited Repair Program: typically up to \$20,000
- Home Revitalization Program: typically up to \$30,000

If the borrower defaults on the loan by selling, transferring the deed or moving out of the home before the full loan is forgiven, the borrower will need to pay the remaining balance.

Programs are designed to help homeowners address needed home repairs, like leaking roofs, faulty plumbing, accessibility improvements, electrical or heating systems and more.

#### Both programs require:

- The property must be located in the City of Raleigh
- Homeowners commit to continue living in the home for at least five (5) years

# How to apply





To start the application process you will need to do the following:

#### Step 1: Fill out and sign the form.

Fill out the application form attached to this document.

#### **Step 2: Gather supporting documents.**

To complete your eligibility screening, you must submit this application form along with copies of these supporting documents:

- Copy of federal income tax return from last year, and the last two (2) years if you are self-employed
  - If your yearly income does not meet the minimum required to file a federal return,
     send proof of income for the last two (2) years
- Copy of photo ID

You may mark through social security or account numbers, but names and dates must be visible.

#### **Step 3:** Submit application form and supporting documents

Submit the form and copies of your supporting documents to Preserving Home.

#### What to expect next

Once Preserving Home receives your application, they will contact you to confirm that it has been received and/or to request documents. If you provide an email address that will be checked on a regular basis on this application, they will email you. Otherwise, they will call or text you. As a last resort, they will send you mail via USPS.

Once your application and supporting paperwork has been reviewed Preserving Home will contact you again to communicate next steps.
