The Raleigh Digital Connectors Internship program is a unique opportunity for you and your peers to serve your community through technology, community service and leadership. You will become an intern and volunteer for the Digital Inclusion unit with the City of Raleigh's Housing and Neighborhood's Department. The City of Raleigh provides this internship opportunity through strategic partnerships and offers expanded levels of digital readiness and leadership training.

Many students from around the City of Raleigh will apply for the program, so make sure that your application stands out among the very best. Please answer all questions completely. Based on the applications we receive, a group of candidates will be chosen and invited to an interview. A panel of people will interview you, and you will want to arrive prepared, energized, and on time. From the interviews, we will select our finalists and announce the 2021-2022 Raleigh Digital Connectors.

COVID-19 Program Preparedness

Amidst the continued concern for safety regarding the COVID-19 Pandemic, we are making efforts to conduct interviews in late August in a virtual setting. If you are selected for an interview, then you will be asked if you have the technological capability to participate in a virtual interview. If you do not have the technological capacity to participate in a virtual interview, then we will discuss a safe alternative.

We are making a strategic effort to create a socially distanced and safe computer lab to hold in person sessions for the upcoming Raleigh Digital Connectors program. We will still have capacity to go virtual during any point of the nine-month program cycle.
