- What are things we should be thinking about for those in the study area experiencing homelessness?
 - There are cities around the US that designated areas where people could put their tent.
 - There is a gap for families with children that are experiencing homelessness. There is also a gap for transgender people experiencing homelessness who may be denied access to gendered shelters. Triangle Family services helps to fill this gap. Alice Lutz is the executive director.
 - Maybe talking to homeless population can help identify solutions
 - Some may prefer to live outside of shelters, but there are potential issues including trash and fire.
 - A program to build housing for those who are ready to be housed.
 - There are programs that are trying to address these issues, but it is not an easy issue to address.

 - Are there ways that outreach to those experiencing homelessness can be improved?
 - Personal relationships can help alleviate issues and fill in gaps where organizations are aren't reaching.
 - How can we think about urban public space differently? What types of uses can front on public areas and understand how we can make this area as a welcoming area. What public space do we have in this study area and who is it for?
 - Is there room in public space to support more housing for the homeless population.
