ORDINANCE NO. XX-XXX TC-3-21

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL THE CURRENT STANDARDS CONTAINED IN ARTICLE 8.5 OF THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE AND REPLACE WITH UNIFIED STANDARDS FOR NEW STREETS

WHEREAS, the city of Raleigh Unified Development Ordinance and Raleigh Street Design Manual contain standards for new streets and expansion of existing streets; and

WHEREAS, the Unified Development Ordinance and Raleigh Street Design Manual contain development standards that are applied during subdivision and site plan review; and


WHEREAS, the standards applied during administrative review must be objective in nature and equitably applied; and

WHEREAS, the adopted BikeRaleigh Plan and 2030 Comprehensive Plan call for the implementation of a network of bicycle facilities;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RALEIGH THAT:

Section 1. Sections 8.5.5 Mixed Use Streets of the Part 10 Raleigh Unified Development Ordinance, Street Types, is hereby is hereby amended by adding the following language shown in the underlined and removing the language shown in strikethrough:

Section 3. The Raleigh Street Design Manual shall be updated in accordance with the approved language contained within the ordinance.

Section 4. All laws and clauses of laws in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. If this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the ordinance which can be given separate effect and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 6. This text change has been reviewed by the Raleigh Planning Commission.

Section 7. This ordinance has been adopted following a duly advertised public hearing of the Raleigh City Council.

Section 8. This ordinance has been provided to the North Carolina Capital Planning Commission as required by law.

Section 9. This ordinance shall be enforced as provided in N.C.G.S. 160A-175 or as provided in the Raleigh City Code. All criminal sanctions shall be the maximum allowed by law notwithstanding the fifty-dollar limit in N.C.G.S. §14-4(a) or similar limitations.

Section 10. This ordinance is effective days after adoption.
