Conditions dated: January 3, 2020

- 1. The following uses shall be prohibited: Type B emergency shelters; telecommunications towers; cemeteries; and outdoor sports or entertainment facilities.
- 2. Along the common boundary between the property and the adjacent lots identified in those deeds recorded in the Wake County registry at the books and pages of listed below, an opaque fence at least 6 feet high shall be installed and maintained within five feet of such common boundary except where either (i) a more restrictive standard applies under the Unified Development Ordinance, or (ii) such area is part of a recorded Tree Conservation Area pursuant to Article 9.1 of the Unified Development Ordinance or within any easement required by any governmental authority, in which case no fence shall be required along such common boundary pursuant to this condition.
