

### Community Engagement for the Commerce Place Streetscape Project

The City of Raleigh hosted an in-person event on November 3, 2023, to invite the public to give feedback on how to transform Commerce Place into a pedestrian-oriented street. Following the event, an online survey was posted with similar questions, to gage interest and ideas from a wider audience. The feedback provided from both community engagement channels will be used to inform the long-term improvements to the street in the coming years.









A place for people – no cars!


No cars. No parking! Just a place for people.




