Looking Ahead to 2026

The Raleigh Police Department continues its commitment to the safety and well-being of every resident and visitor in 2026. We are prioritizing the following initiatives:

- Launch **Crime Mapper** – This digital tool will allow anyone in the community to easily access and review crime statistics.
- Begin **Autism Awareness Training** – Officers will receive instruction focused on understanding and effectively interacting with individuals who have autism and/or intellectual or developmental disabilities.
- Expand **ConnectRaleigh** – RPD's community video-sharing program enables residents and businesses to play an active role in enhancing public safety. Community members register their security cameras to help identify area cameras in case of an incident. This program is supported by the **Raleigh Police Department Foundation (RPDF)**.
- Continue **Community Police Academies** – RPD will continue its community engagement initiatives, including the Community Police Academy.
