Homicides:

- 9 of the 11 homicides are closed.
 - I was deemed justifiable.
 - Of the 8 remaining homicides, the suspect was known to the victim.
- 6 of the 11 homicides occurred in January.

Aggravated Assaults:

- 39% of total incidents involved a firearm.
- Arrests have been made in 30% of the Aggravated Assaults (Firearm) incidents.
- Juveniles have been charged in 5 Aggravated Assaults (Firearm) incidents.
- · Many of these investigations are ongoing.



Motor Vehicle Thefts:

- 421* vehicles were recovered.
- The Auto Theft Task Force (ATTF) continues to focus on identifying suspects responsible for motor vehicle thefts using technology and partnerships with other agencies.
- Reminders:
