The Raleigh Police Department continues its commitment to the safety and well-being of every community member in 2026. Next quarter, we are prioritizing the following initiatives:

- **Raleigh Hoops Nights** provides opportunities for officers and youth to connect through basketball during the summer months. Our kick-off event will be held on June 20.
- **Connect Raleigh** is a video camera sharing public safety program enabling the people of Raleigh to help keep their community safe. Register your camera at connectraleigh.org.
- Our **DWI Unit**, supported by the Governor's Highway Safety Patrol, uses saturation patrols to target impaired driving and prevent crashes.
- June is **Gun Violence Prevention Month**; the department will support awareness and outreach efforts focused on responsible firearm storage, education, and violence prevention.
- Our **2026 Summer Action Plan** will begin on June 1 and continue through August 31. The plan outlines key initiatives designed to strengthen community engagement, enhance public safety, and build lasting partnerships throughout the season.
