- Assume full responsibility for any personal injury or any damage to his or her personal property, which may occur, directly or
 indirectly, in the course of participation in the rental of a Raleigh Lakes boat on the date indicated below.
- Fully and forever release and discharge the CITY OF RALEIGH, its agents, officials and employees, from any and all claims, demands, rights of action, or causes of action, present or future, whether the same be known, anticipated or unanticipated, resulting from or arising out of the above described activity.
- Agree that it is the intent of the undersigned that this RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT shall be in full force and effect any time after the execution hereof.
