

## CITY OF RALEIGH PUBLIC ART AND DESIGN BOARD

### 2020-2021 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

The work of the Public Art and Design Board has continued to expand in response to the community's interest in public art and the growing portfolio of "Percent for Art" projects.

1. Managed **18** active public art projects in various stages of design, fabrication, or installation.
2. The Percent for Art portfolio is now over \$4.1 million for public art projects funded through the allocation; to date **14** Percent for Art projects have been completed, and **13** are in progress.
3. Completed Installation of integrated artwork at John Chavis Memorial Park
4. In collaboration with Transit, the PADB oversaw the City's first Artist in Residence Program as a part of the Bus Rapid Transit Project.
5. Initiated the City's first Public Art Plan - participating in workshops, review of drafts, and public engagement.
6. Consulted on the Concept and Final Designs for Civic Campus East Tower, Carolina Pines Avenue, Marsh Creek / Trawick Avenue, Atlantic Avenue, Blue Ridge Road, Barwell Road and Poole Road.
7. Placed three artists from the mentorship program as collaborators with seasoned Public Artists on three public art projects.
8. Reviewed and consulted on the Artist Call for Dix Park Play Plaza.
9. Oversaw the Artist Selection Process for Dix Park Play Plaza.
