The Basics of Bookmaking

Books can come in all sorts of shapes, sizes, and styles. In this workshop, we will learn the basics of bookmaking starting from creating simple accordion-style books with single sheets of paper. Then, we will move on to making a simple pamphlet book using cereal boxes. Finally, we will culminate in making a Japanese stab stitch book using new and recycled materials. We'll mix the marbling medium of carragheenan and treat drawing papers, book pages, and textiles with an alum mordant (fixative). We'll float acrylic paints on the marbling medium, then splatter, drop, swirl and comb the paints to a beautiful design before transferring onto large sheets of drawing paper to be used as covers and endpapers in your future book projects. We'll also experiment marbling on fabrics, maps, or old book pages. And finally, we'll marble over our least-favorite marbled papers to create complex and uniquely beautiful patterns. \$60 supply fee to the instructor at the first class. 4 sessions.

A Step Beyond Bookmaking
