Printmaking – Learn to Screen Print

Students will have use of one of Pullen Arts Centers 11x14 screens for the duration of the class. Black fabric ink is supplied for use during class time.

- Two 11 x 14' screen printing frames are recommended only available at Jerry's Artarama. You can purchase larger or smaller frames depending on your budget.
- Whatever you would like to print on: t-shirts, sweatshirts, aprons, bags, etc. (Michaels has good deals on t-shirts, or the Mortex outlet in Wendell, NC is extra cheap). Make sure fabrics are 100% cotton or 50/50 cotton/acrylic blend for best results.
- Bring an idea for your first project. You will want a high-contrast image where the lines aren't too thin.
- Optional:
 - Your own squeegee for printing at home
 - Paper for printing Arches cover or Stonehenge work well or online HERE
 - Speedball FABRIC Screen Print ink black and any other color you want to print with. Another good brand is Jacquard (for dark fabrics you want OPAQUE ink.)
