The North Carolina State Capitol, serving as the seat of state government since its opening in June 1840, offers a glimpse into the state's political past. The Executive Mansion, completed in 1891, has been home to successive Governors and First Families, remaining in continuous use throughout the 20th century. The North Carolina General Assembly building stands out as it is exclusively dedicated to the legislative branch of state government.
