Do you love scenic southern towns with charm and history? Come and explore Hillsborough, NC. We will be leaving from the Anne Gordon Active Adult Center at Millbrook Exchange Park (1901 Spring Forest Road) at 9am.

Hillsborough is no ordinary southern small town, the downtown has more than 100 homes, churches, schools and other structures on the Register of Historical Places. Now the downtown is home to restaurants, art galleries and a haven for artist and



writers alike. The day will begin with a visit to the Alexander Dickson House, used by a Confederate General as an office space during the civil war, now the home of the visitors center. Next, visit the Burwell School, the setting for one of the state's earliest schools for girls and then the home of Elizabeth Hobbs. Hobbs was a Burwell family slave and a talented seamstress who possessed drive and determination. She later married, buying her freedom, and became a successful businesswoman and the confidante of First Lady Mary Todd Lincoln. Following lunch (on your own) and time to explore the unique shops, galleries and/or historical sights the group will visit the Ayr Mount. This Federal-era plantation house, built in 1815, was unique for its time period with 14ft ceilings, woodwork and plasterwork found throughout the house.

We recommend you wear comfortable walking shoes for this trip. Please note that not all parts of the homes are handicap accessible with stairs to the second and third floor, however, there are pictures with descriptions of the upper floors. The group will arrive back in Raleigh at approximately 5:00pm.
