# Bat Testing

In all Adult Softball leagues and levels of play, players must have their bat tested by a City of Raleigh Parks, Recreation and Cultural Resources Athletics Division representative, and with the certified association bat tester. All bats must be tested before your first game.

### 2023 Bat Protest Rule and Procedures

Each team can protest a bat during league or tournament play. The protest fee is \$50 (payable only by check or cash). The bat protest fee must be submitted to the Athletics staff onsite at the time of the protest.

Only the listed team manager may submit a bat protest. Bat protests can only occur at any point during regulation game time and must take place during the time at which the opponent with the bat steps into the batter's box or before the first legal pitch to the next batter in the lineup.
