






Welcome to Raleigh Parks!

Capital Area Greenway System

The Capital Area Greenway System began in the 1970s as a way to manage stormwater and protect flood-prone areas. From the start, it helped protect Raleigh's waterways and provided recreation opportunities.

Today, the system includes linear parks and trails along rivers, creeks, utility and railroad corridors, and roadways. These trails connect people to parks, cultural and historic sites, and major destinations while preserving natural areas. Most trails are 10-foot-wide paved paths for walking, jogging, biking, skating, or commuting.

The greenway system includes 120 miles of protected open space corridors following the Neuse River, Crabtree Creek, Walnut Creek, and many others. Whether you're spotting wildlife, getting active, or commuting, we hope you enjoy exploring this connected trail network!
