 - \$18 supply fee to be paid to instructor at first class for cording, fiberfill and interfacing.
- Fabric should be washed, dried and pressed prior to class. Sertoma will provide the sewing machines.

Current students should bring projects they are working on.

Potential students are highly encouraged to visit a class and are required to contact the instructor before enrolling. New students purchase the appropriate kit of tools and supplies from the instructor. The supplies and tools for this class all originate in Japan. One month's advance notice is needed to order supplies for new students.

There are 2 kit options for new students:

1. Two small designs on silk fabric, design is printed in color and stitching is added to some areas. Embroidery frames and tools will be provided for use during class time only. Students will take the embroidery home when completed. Kit fee is \$80, cash or check, payable at the first class. At least one full weekend is required to complete the piece. A good option to try it out.
 2. The first official curriculum design, for students who plan to continue studying. All the design is stitched. Students will buy the full kit of frame, tools, fabric and fiber, total cost is approximately \$300. Multiple classes are required to complete the design.
