

Mordecai Historic Park Electrical and Mechanical Improvements



Project Description

Mordecai Historic Park is located on the grounds of the former Mordecai Plantation and part of the Raleigh park system since the 1960's. The park site is composed of eight historically-significant buildings, including the Mordecai Plantation house, and hosts numerous interpretive programs, events, and tours.

The project is based around updating the aging electrical and mechanical systems throughout the park. Improvements include:

- Installation of an underground electrical and water services connecting multiple park buildings.
- New HVAC and humidification systems in several buildings.
- Basement sump and waterproofing system in the Badger-Iredell Office building.
