# Call for Art

## About the Pullen Arts Center

We are a visual arts community education center providing artists of all ages and levels of experience with skill-building classes led by professional teaching artists. Our facility features fully equipped bookmaking/printmaking, jewelry, pottery and painting studios and a large gallery space with exhibitions that rotate every 3 months.

## We prioritize the artist.

Pullen Arts Center is a zero-commission art gallery. Our galleries showcase a broad spectrum of visual arts from local, regional, and national artists. We provide artists with exhibition opportunities and space to engage with the community. The galleries are free, open to the public, and are a valued component of the community arts education experience.

## Who can show their artworks at Pullen Arts Center?

Persons 18+ years of age, residing in the City of Raleigh, who participate or make art at Pullen Arts Center are prioritized. However, artists working across the region are encouraged to apply. We define "all artists" to include the range of human differences (race and ethnicity, gender identity, age, socio-economic and housing status, religion, political affiliation, physical and mental ability) and the broadest definition of an arts professional. All artists are welcome to apply.

## What kind of artworks can be displayed?

Artists working in any medium are encouraged to apply. This could include works in progress, hybridized practices, and collaborative projects, in addition to book and print arts, ceramics, drawing and painting, fibers, glass and metal arts. Digital artworks would be considered for exhibition, but the art center has limited equipment available.

## When is the due date for submissions?

The 70-day digital SlideRoom submission period begins March 11, 2024, and ends at 11:59 p.m. on May 20, 2024. Mail-in proposals must be postmarked by Monday, May 6, 2024 and delivered to 105 Pullen Road, Raleigh, NC 27607. Review process is May 21, 2024 through June 21, 2024. Artists will be informed of selections by Monday, July 1, 2024.
