#### Lead Instructor:

- Plan and execute lessons and activities for each class.
- Mentor and work with a co-instructor and/or TESOL Intern to help with lesson planning.
- 3. Substitute for other classes when available.

#### Co-Instructor:

- 1. Help lead instructor with planning and executing lessons.
- 2. Fill in for the lead instructor when needed.

#### TESOL Intern:

- Observe classes and share observations with the COE Program Office.
- 2. Help instructor with planning and executing of lessons.
