Track Out X-Press Program Grades K-5

Track Out X-Press strives to provide high quality activities and new learning opportunities at a reasonable cost for children who are tracked out of year-round or modified schools. Members of the program staff complete training in areas such as first-aid, behavior management and age-appropriate activity planning. This enables them to provide a safe environment in which children can play and learn.

The program provides a stimulating atmosphere through organized activities such as recreational games and sports, field trips and arts and crafts, as well as many learning opportunities through food experiences, science and nature activities and computer technology. Participants will receive a program T-shirt that should be worn on all field trips other than swimming pools. Each participant must bring a lunch, drinks, and two snacks, and should dress for play, including sneakers/athletic shoes.

This wonderful recreational opportunity provides a safe alternative to children having to stay home while their parents work. Participants interact with their peers and counselors in fun-filled activities such as sports, arts & crafts, games, movies, and a variety of other exciting events. Location Changes and Refunds:

Elections may impact site availability. If minimum registration requirements are not met for a specific date at a location, parents/guardians will be notified at least five days in advance and given the option to change locations or receive a full refund for that date.

Friendly Track Out Ages 6-12

Friendly Track Out is designed to meet the needs of students, with developmental disabilities, who attend school on Track 4. Each week features structured recreation, field trips, leisure and social activities. Friendly Track Out is available for Breaks 2-4. Camp Friendly is available during the summer Track Out Break 1. (See the Summer Camp brochure for information about Camp Friendly.) Participants must be able to participate successfully within a 1:3 staff to participant ratio. Students who require more assistance or supervision may attend with a personal assistant. (Additional paperwork is required at least two weeks in advance.)

Behavior: staff will provide positive behavior support, redirection, preferred activities, and use behavior support strategies provided by families. Participants are expected to exhibit appropriate program behavior, without presenting a safety concern to themselves, other campers or staff.

Feeding: staff will provide verbal and visual prompting, reminders, assist with placement of food, break up food into small pieces, open containers for the participant. Participants should be able to physically feed themselves.

Participation: staff will engage participant through multiple means of instruction, sensory engagement, supported transitions, and program modifications. Participants are expected to stay with their group, follow given/modeled direction, and demonstrate engagement during program activities, during transitions, and in the community on field trips.

Toileting and Personal Care: staff will provide verbal and visual prompting, minimally assist camper with pull-up/diaper and/or clothing. Participant should be able to clean/wipe themselves with minimal assistance from staff.

Walk-In Registration Will Begin June 1, 2023

Program availability may be limited. Registration forms will be available online and at the Recreation Business Office.

All walk-in registration will be processed only at the Recreation Business Office located at **2401 Wade Ave, Raleigh, NC 27607**. Note: Families may choose a payment plan option but the initial deposit is due at the time of registration.

Activity Cancellation: When an activity is canceled by Raleigh Parks, fees are 100% refundable.

- Any participant wishing to withdraw from an activity or league must do so at least 14 days prior to the scheduled start of the activity or league. Refunds must be requested online through RecLink by email to reclinksupport@raleighnc.gov or to the Recreation Business Office at rbo.registration@raleighnc.gov
- Withdrawal and cancellation requests after the 14-day notice period will be granted, but no refund will be given, with the exception of approved medical or hardship cases.
 Medical and hardship cases are considered on a case-bycase basis and may require additional documentation.
- Non-attendance or non-participation in an activity does not entitle the patron to a refund/credit.

Refunds/Credits

- Please allow up to 2 weeks for your refund to be processed.
- Payments made by credit card will be refunded to the original method of payment.
- Payments made by cash or check will be refunded as a check
- If you wish to leave your credit on your account, the credit will be valid for one (1) year. By leaving the credit on the account, the participant also agrees that credits remaining inactive after one (1) year will be donated to the Raleigh Scholarship Fund, without further notification.

Enrollment on the waiting list does not guarantee program placement. If space becomes available in the program, you will be notified by email or telephone. You will have until the end of the following business day to accept and remit payment for the requested program. Your acceptance must be confirmed in writing. If notification is not received within the specified timeframe, you will forfeit your participant's placement. There is no charge to be on the waiting list.
