Know Before You Go



Wellness checks will be required for all Trolley guests

- During the screening, you will be asked a few short questions and a temperature check will be performed using a touchless thermometer.
 - Anyone that does not pass the wellness screening will not be allowed aboard the trolley.
 - A wristband will be given to each person to wear that indicates they have passed their wellness screening.
 - All patrons five years or older must wear a mask at all times within the Trolley and maintain 6 feet of distance when possible.
 - Participants should remain on their assigned bench within the Trolley for the duration of the tour.

Cleaning Procedures

- The Trolley will receive a thorough cleaning in between tours. This will include the sanitizing of seating area and high-touch areas like handles and windows.
- Hand Sanitizer will be available for all guests in the Moore Square & Mordecai Visitor Centers and onboard the trolley.

Tips for a Successful Trolley Experience:

- Patrons should make all guests aware of the facility guidelines in advance of their participation in the Trolley Tours, including the wellness screening process and mask requirements.
- Patrons may need to allot extra time for guests to clear the wellness screening and enter the facility and should plan accordingly based upon need and number of guests.
- If you have specific questions or concerns prior to your tour, please work with the facility staff that manage that site to ensure all of your questions are addressed prior to your tour date.
