- If a participant would like to request an interpreter for a specific program, please contact our office at the time of registration. We request notification at least 2 weeks prior to the start date of the program.
- Personal care is not provided. Participants who wish to attend but need a higher level of support/supervision may attend, and must register a Personal Assistant to provide the needed support/supervision.
*Additional forms apply.
- Additional forms for day or overnight trips, or other specific programs may be required and will be sent out as needed.

The HIP Program is a social club for deaf and hard-of-hearing participants of all ages.
