

Raleigh Water - Project Share Award

Purpose

Eligibility

• **Individuals:** Raleigh residents who have initiated or participated in fundraising campaigns, awareness-raising activities, or other initiatives to support Raleigh Water's Project Share program.

• **Groups/Organizations/Schools:** Community organizations, schools, or businesses that have developed and implemented programs or campaigns to raise funds or awareness for Raleigh Water's Project Share program.

Criteria for Selection

• **Impact:** The extent to which the nominee's actions have raised awareness of Raleigh Water's Project Share program and generated financial support.

- **Innovation:** The creativity and originality of the nominee's approach to fundraising and awareness-raising.
- **Sustainability:** The nominee's commitment to long-term environmental sustainability and community well-being.
- **Community Engagement:** The nominee's involvement in outreach and education efforts related to the Project Share program.

• **Campaign Effectiveness:** The success of the nominee's fundraising or awareness-raising campaign in terms of reaching its goals and making a positive impact on the Project Share program.
