Public Transit

Not just the bus!

GoRaleigh makes riding the bus an easy, affordable, and convenient option. Historically, the GoPass program has allowed employers to provide passes for employees to ride GoRaleigh and other regional buses. Visit GoRaleigh.org for more information. In Raleigh, we also have Amtrak train service. Amtrak is a great option for commuting longer distances or for out-of-town work trips. Carpooling

Share the ride; share the convenience.

Carpooling is an excellent alternative to driving alone and a great way to save on driving expenses. A carpool is two or more people riding together in the same vehicle and is one of the most flexible commute options available. Depending on who is available, it can be scheduled as many times in the week as needed. The designated carpool driver can be rotated on a daily, weekly, or monthly basis. A plan to share things like fuel costs can be worked out amongst those in the carpool.

On-site Amenities

Employers that provide convenient on-site amenities for employees reduce the need for a car to run personal errands. By having necessary amenities on-site or available within walking distance, employers can reduce the employee need to drive off-site and add to traffic congestion.
