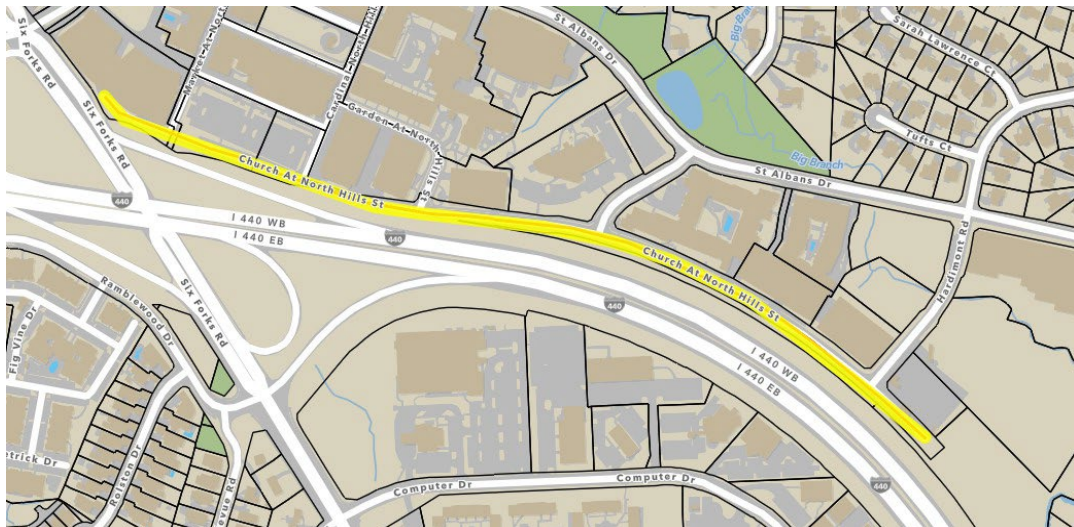
A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE STREET NAME OF CHURCH AT NORTH HILLS STREET TO BRIDGE AT NORTH HILLS STREET

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RALEIGH, NORTH CAROLINA:

Section 1. That the street named Church at North Hills Street be changed to Bridge at North Hills Street as authorized for consideration by Resolution of Intent No. 2026-777 on May, 19, 2026.

Section 2. That the section of roadway whose name is to be changed is described as follows:

SNC-01-2026 – Church at North Hills Street – From dead end to dead end be changed to **Bridge at North Hills Street**.



Section 3.

Conditions:

1. City of Raleigh Transportation Department erect new street name signs along the roadways where current signs are currently in place no later than five working days after the effective date.

Section 4. This name change shall in no way be construed to affect the validity of any traffic and/or parking regulations applicable to this driveway. Accordingly, the City of Raleigh Director of Transportation and the City of Raleigh City Clerk are directed to make conforming name changes in any traffic and/or parking regulations applicable to the above-mentioned street.
