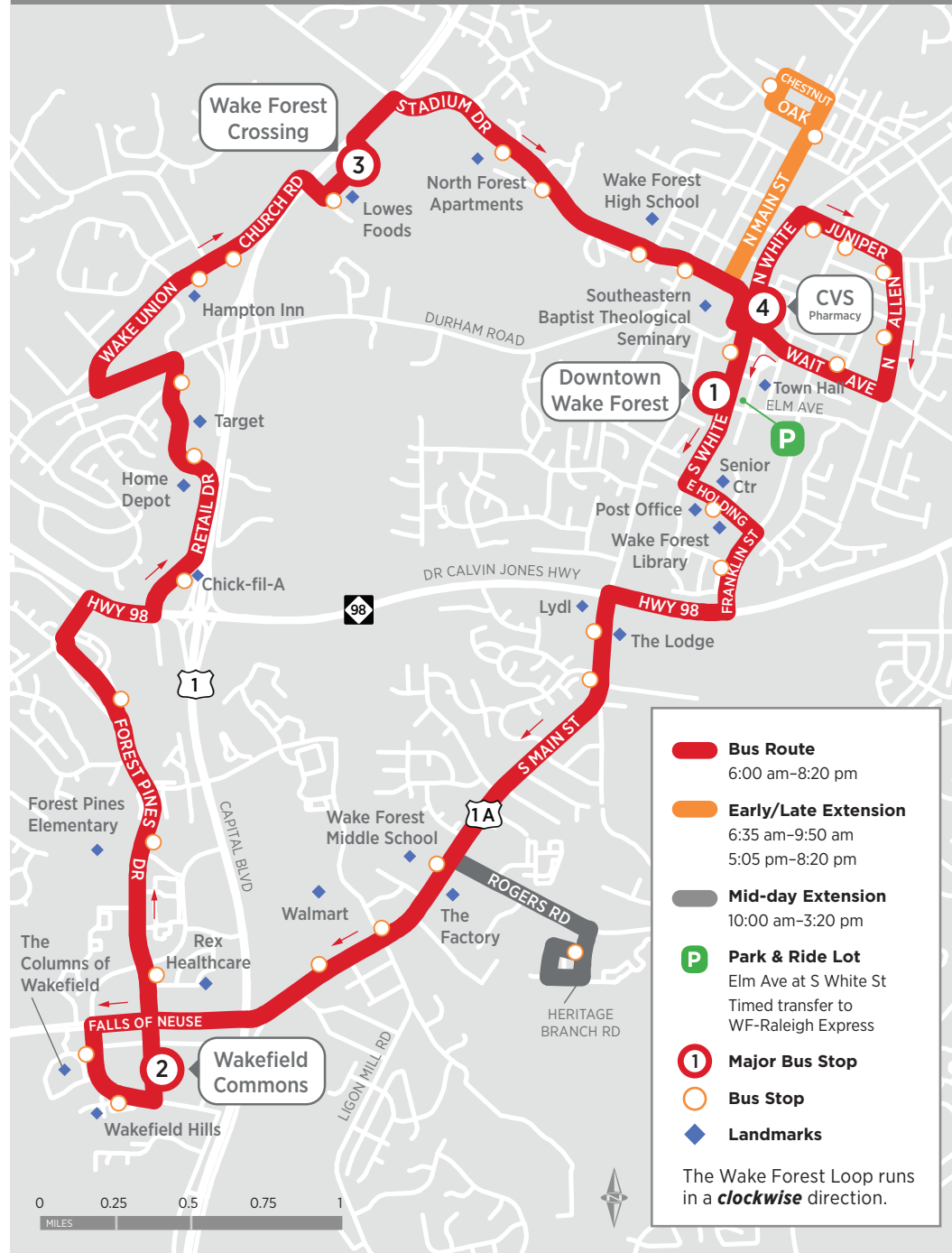

The Wake Forest Loop is provided through a partnership between the Town of Wake Forest, the City of Raleigh and GoRaleigh. All buses are GoRaleigh vehicles.

Accessibility

The Town of Wake Forest is committed to offering a bus system that residents of all abilities can enjoy. All buses are wheelchair accessible and offer talking bus features for the visually impaired. If you have limited mobility, please ask the driver to lower the bus so that you may step aboard.

ADA Accessible Paratransit Services

If you are a Wake Forest resident with a physical or mental disability that makes it impossible to drive a car and/or use Wake Forest Bus Service, you may qualify for GoRaleigh Access. This program provides subsidized curb-to-curb transportation service through participating contractors. The program in Wake Forest is administered by the City of Raleigh and funded by the Town of Wake Forest. Call 919-435-9441 for more information.

Can I bring my bike on the bus?

Yes. Bikes are allowed on the two racks on the front of the bus. Bikes are not currently allowed on the inside of the bus. Make sure that when retrieving your bike, you are fully on the curb or sidewalk before the bus pulls away. Review rules of the road and think safety first when riding your bike to the bus stop.

Park & Ride Lot

The Wake Forest Park & Ride Lot is located in the downtown area on Elm Avenue at the South White Street intersection. Parking is free. To see all park and ride lots available in the area, visit GoRaleigh.org.

Tips for riding the bus

- The bus will stop at designated bus stop signs along the route. To board the bus, signal to the driver as he approaches the stop.
- When you want to exit the bus, press the strip or pull the cord located above the seats at least one-half block before your stop.
- Whenever possible, exit the bus through the rear doors.

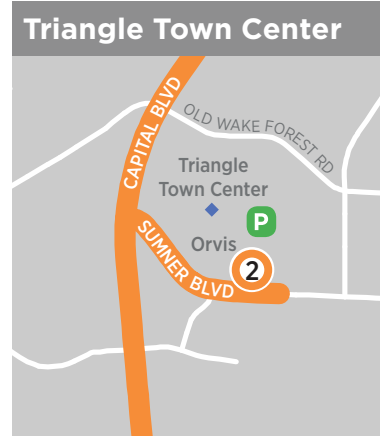
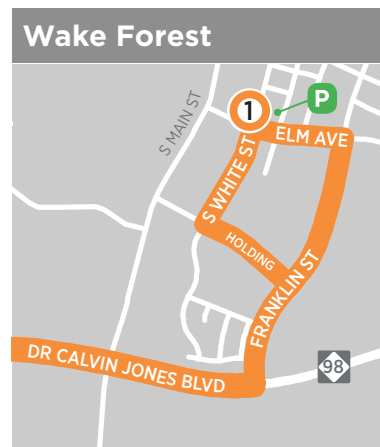
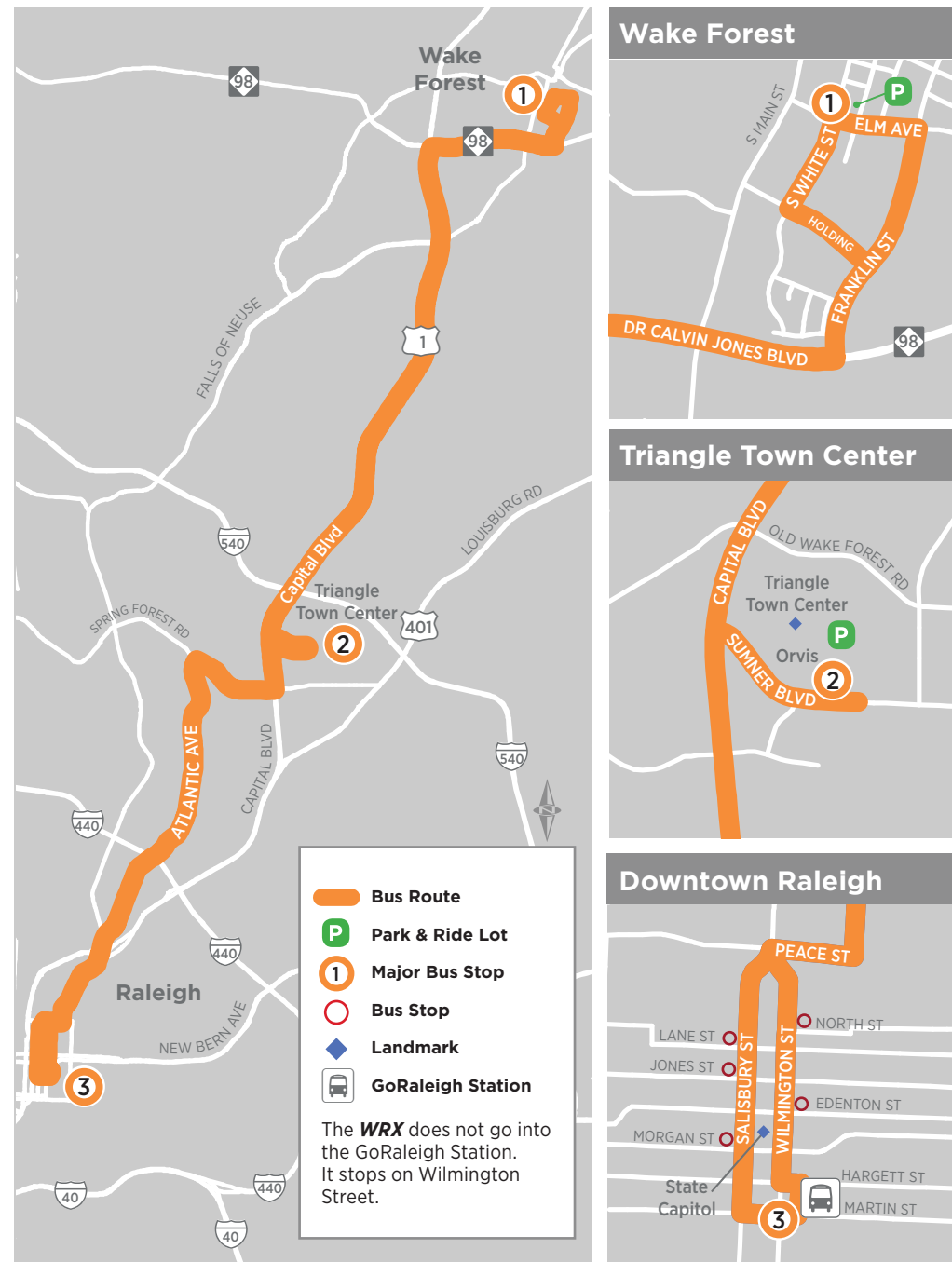
