




Street Improvement Petitions

- Petitions issued for local streets upon request
- Assessments for curb and gutter:
 - ❖ \$32 per linear foot of residential frontage
 - ❖ \$64 per linear foot of non-residential frontage
- Complete streets policy requires sidewalk
- Only property owners can sign petition
- Being majority of property owners <u>and</u> representing a majority of frontage being improved

 - \$32 per linear foot
 - Estimated total: \$119,630










Petition map illustrating improvements and petition results map 1 of 3


