Program/ Service Type	Description	Maximum Allowable Rate	Billing Unit
<b>Adult Day Health Services</b>	Provide structured therapeutic health services and supervised activities for persons with physical, mental, intellectual disabilities, or seniors who receive in-home services.	\$37.00	Per Day
<b>After-School Program</b>	Provide healthy social, cultural, educational or physical activities for elementary, middle or high school aged youth after school.	\$20.00	Per Hour
<b>Case Management Services</b>	Provide services to help clients gain access to needed medical, social, educational and other services.	\$54.00	Per Hour
<b>Comprehensive Vision Screening</b>	Program provides comprehensive eye exams and services to detect and treat vision problems and eye disease.	\$65.00	Per Screening
<b>Detoxification Services</b>	Program provides shelter, support and resources for individuals who receive detoxification services.	\$123.00	Per Day
<b>Early Childhood Intervention</b>	Provide services and supports to infants and young children with developmental delays and disabilities and their families.	\$108.00	Per Hour
<b>Educational Trainings &amp; Workshops</b>	Coordinated programs and educational services provided in the form of trainings and workshops that enhance the quality of life of low-income residents.	\$55.00	Per Workshop/ Training
<b>Emergency Shelter</b>	Provide temporary shelter for homeless individuals and families. Additional services may include, food, clothing, emergency financial assistance and assistance in accessing other support services.	\$53.00	Per Day
<b>Food Delivery Services</b>	Targeted nutritious food or meal delivery services for individuals in need. This may include meal preparation, delivery and distribution.	\$7.00	Each
<b>Food Distribution Services (Per Pound)</b>	Targeted nutritious food or meal distribution for individuals in need. This includes food distributed by the pound.	\$0.06	Per Pound

<b>Hospice Services</b>	Provide supportive care to people in the final phase of a terminal illness with a focus on comfort and quality of life.	\$205.00	Per Day
<b>Housing Support Services</b>	Assist individuals in the creation of housing support plans and foster the development of independent living skills.	\$67.00	Per Hour
<b>In-Home Aide</b>	Provide in- home services to elderly residents and their caregivers with the intention for recipients to continue to live in their homes and avoid institutional placement.	\$22.00	Per Hour
<b>Legal Services</b>	Provide direct legal representation, advocacy or legal advice in non-criminal matters. Assistance with connecting the enrollee to expert community resources to address legal issues.	\$64.00	Per Hour
<b>Mental Health Services</b>	Provide assessment, diagnosis, treatment or counseling to assist an individual or group in alleviating mental or emotional illness, symptoms, conditions or disorders.	\$59.00	Per Hour
<b>Mentoring Services</b>	Program to improve the well-being of youth by providing a role model that can support the youth academically, socially and/or personally.	\$22.00	Per Hour
<b>Prescription Assistance Program</b>	Program to help patients who lack health insurance or prescription drug coverage obtain the medications they need.	\$69.00	Per Prescription
<b>Primary Care Services</b>	Provide access to comprehensive, primary medical care to low- income individuals.	\$110.00	Per Visit
<b>Short-Term Family &amp; Temporary Housing</b>	Provide temporary housing and comprehensive supportive services with the goal of independent living and self-sufficiency. Additional services may include, meals, assistance with job search and access to prevention and intervention services.	\$47.00	Per Day
<b>Supported Employment/ Vocational Support</b>	Provide assistance with choosing, acquiring, and maintaining employment for individuals.	\$39.00	Per Hour
<b>Supportive Housing</b>	Provide permanent housing for low-income individuals who may have been homeless in the past, or otherwise need access to more intensive social services.	\$33.00	Per Hour
<b>Tutoring Services</b>	Program that provides additional, special, or basic academic instruction to elementary, middle or high school aged youth.	\$20.00	Per Hour
